



OBJECTIVE

The 11th edition of the contest "ONE CLICK, ONE SMILE" of Mumbai Smiles is here. We invite you to participate and contribute with this gesture in the fight pacífica against poverty, for equal opportunities and respect for human rights in Mumbai.

It is very simple, you only have to send your photographs related to the theme proposed for this edition of the competition. If they win, they will be part of the **Charity Calendar 2021**.

The beneficios generated by the sale of this calendar, will go to projects supporting victims of trafficking in the so-called "red light districts" and children from homeless families who subsist in the streets of the city of Mumbai, related to education, health and socio-economic development. This year the funds will also go to our actions in Mumbai to fight the hunger that the Covid-19 pandemic has caused in the city's most vulnerable communities.

PARTICIPANTS

The contest is open to any person, professional or aficionada photographer, who has visited India and is interested in participating.

No member of the Mumbai Smiles team, or anyone with a professional relationship with Mumbai Smiles during the months of this competition is eligible to participate.

Participation in the competition implies acceptance of its rules.

THEME

The Journey of a Lifetime: India

In this 11th edition of the contest will have room for all the photographs that show cultural and emblematic places of the country and also all those magical and special corners that you have discovered during your travels through the different cities and towns, and that show the diversity that India offers.

The objective is to awaken the interest of new travellers so that when the situation allows it, they can travel again to the country where we carry out our projects.

India is a vast country that comprises a variety of territories ranging from the peaks of the Himalayas to the shores of the Indian Ocean. In addition, its great historical past, the fusion of its population and the diverse influencias of other cultures, have provided the country with many tourist places to visit.



India has monuments of the Moghul empire, majestic religious sanctuaries, edificacolonial era, constructions of the Islamic architecture and admirable natural landscapes that do not leave indifferent to anyone who visits the country.

Thus, the competition will include all those photographs that show this historical and cultural richness of the country. We want to transmit with your images that there are many charms and attractions that awaken the senses of travelers who come to India.

We are looking for images that, once we are back to normal and the trips to India can be reactivated, will encourage people to visit those corners of some village in the mountains of Rishikesh, or the sunsets in the backwaters of Kerala, or a beautiful sunrise in front of the Taj Mahal. They can be photographs of monuments, landscapes, outdoors or indoors that convey what may be the next "Journey of a lifetime".

In this edition, photographs that do not show images of people will be valued.

You can now start sending us those images that you have captured on your travels that are related to the theme proposed.

DELIVERY AND DEADLINE

Photographs should be sent by e-mail to eventos@sonrisasdebombay.org.

It must be clearly indicated:

- Title of the photograph, think of a creative name for your image.
- Date and place específico of the photo was taken
- Author's data: name and surname, e-mail, contact telephone and postal address.

The deadline for submission of photographs is **September 20, 2020**.



RULES

Each participant may submit a maximum of 3 photographs. The characteristics of the photographs are:

- JPG format
- Minimum resolution of 300 dpi
- Minimum size of 2MB and maximum of 6MB.
- Can only be color photos, not black and white.
- 1. Participation is individual. A photo can not be firmada by two or more authors, if so will be descalificada.
- 2. Those photos that do not respect the dignity of the person, that degrade his image or that attempt against his privacy will not be admitted to the contest.
- 3. The author of the photograph cannot appear in the image. If people appear, only local people can appear.
- 4. Participants may only submit photographs of their own authorship, which have not resulted in fina- lists or winners in other competitions.
- The photographs may not be altered electronically or in any other way.
 Photomontages will not be accepted. Corrections of colour and luminosity will be allowed.
- 6. The photographs finalistas and winners will become part of the image gallery of Smiles of Mumbai.
- 7. Any submission that does not comply with the above rules will be automatically rejected by the jury.



JURY'S DECISION

The jury will be made up of members of the staff of Mumbai Smiles and professional photographers who collaborate with the organization.

Mumbai Smiles guarantees that the jury will not be privy to the personal details of the participants throughout the selection process.

12 photographs will be selected finalists and of these, 3 photographs will be awarded a prize. The jury's decision will be final.

Publication of the winners and finalists: the selection will be published on our website and blog the week of October 5th. The finalists will be notified in writing by email.

PRIZES

The authors of the photographs finalists and winners will receive the following prizes:

Publication of the photograph in the charity calendar that we will publish for Christmas 2021. The benefits from the sale, as every year, will be allocated to our cooperation projects in Mumbai.

The authors of the 12 photographs finalistas will receive a calendar as a gift.

The three winners will receive: the book "Women of Bombay, India's bravest", by Jaume Sanllorente, founder and General Director of Mumbai Smiles.
